Incident: Strong Armed Robbery

Suspects: 5 Unknown B/M Juveniles
Synopsis: Quinn was driving her vehicle and stopped at the above location when the suspects punched her in the face through the window and stole a gold chain off of her neck. The area was canvassed for the suspects but no contact was made.

Synopsis: On the above date and time Perez and Morales entered the residence through an **unlocked** front door. A witness observed this and immediately called for police assistance. Numerous units were in the area and caught the suspects fleeing the scene. Both suspects admitted to being in the house but did not have time to take anything. Both suspects are documented 15th St Gang members. Morales was also found to be in possession of a stolen Ipod from an unrelated theft case.

Incident: Burglary Residence - Unoccupied
Location: 19135 US 19 N (Bay Cove Apts)
Report: 09-101871
Date/Time: 10-04-2009 @ 11:10pm
Synopsis: Victim advised he left his apartment at approximately 10am on 09/30/2009 and locked the dead bolt on the front door. When he returned to his apartment at approximately 11:10pm on 10/04/2009, he noticed that his front door was slightly open. The front door appeared to have a pry mark approximately 1.5" in width near the deadbolt, possibly from a crowbar. The deadbolt and front door did not have any other damage, and the doorframe was intact. Nothing appears to have been stolen. No known suspects.

Update: On October 2, 2009, Detectives responded to Morton Plant Hospital and conducted a second interview with Jason Tong. Tong confirmed the details of his original statement and maintained that he had been shot during a robbery attempt. During both interviews, the investigating officers and detectives detected deception in Tong's statement. Assistance was solicited from Probation Officer Deasaro and she accompanied detectives to Tong's residence. Jason Tong ultimately recanted his original statement and admitted accidentally shooting himself on the previous day while possessing a 9mm firearm.

Update: On 10/2/09, Detectives charged Lloyd Neal with a burglary that occurred on 12/20/06 at Charlie's Belleair Amoco, located at 1495 Belleair Road. Neal was identified by forensic evidence left at the scene. Neal was also charged with an auto theft that occurred earlier that date. He used a van stolen from Fountain Square Apartments, located at 1799 North Highland Avenue, as transportation to and from the burglary. Neal is currently serving a life sentence for homicide.
