CLEARWATER POLICE CONDUCTS BACK TO SCHOOL ENFORCEMENT IN SCHOOL ZONES AND BUS STOP AREAS

WHO: Clearwater Police Department
Traffic Enforcement Team
Community Liaison Team
Patrol Zone Officers

WHAT: Operation School STEP (Special Traffic Enforcement Program)

WHEN: August 22 – 25
6:00 am – 5:00 pm

WHERE: School Zones within the City of Clearwater

WHY: The Clearwater Police Department will monitor school zones as children head back for the first day of school on August 22. The Traffic Enforcement Team, Community Liaison Team and Patrol Officers will focus on speeding and safety in school zones and bus stop areas.

Speeding violations in schools zones carry the following minimum fines:

- 1-9 mph over the speed limit = \$156.00
- 10-14 mph over the speed limit = \$306.00
- 15-19 mph over the speed limit = \$406.00
- 20-29 mph over the speed limit = \$456.00
- Over 30 = court appearance

Officers will also patrol bus stops to ensure safe and legal driving and to make sure drivers are following warning lights and stop signals by school buses.

- Drivers must come to a stop behind the school bus when the stop signals are activated and the stop arm is extended.
- Drivers must stop if coming from the opposite direction UNLESS there is a raised median separating the two directions of travel.
