## SANDRA WILSON SELECTED AS CLEARWATER'S DEPUTY CHIEF

**Clearwater, Fla.** – Clearwater Chief of Police Anthony Holloway has selected Special Agent Supervisor (SAS) Sandra Wilson as Deputy Chief of the Clearwater Police Department. Wilson is a 23-year-veteran of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE).

“Ms. Wilson has demonstrated great leadership and decision-making abilities with FDLE. She is a forward thinker and a visionary – qualities that are critical in finding creative solutions in an ever tightening fiscal environment,” said Chief Anthony Holloway.

Wilson began her 25-year-career at her alma mater, the University of Florida. She spent two years at the Alachua County Sheriff's Office before she was recruited by FDLE. She holds a Masters Degree in Business Administration and has been entrusted with managing key investigative, operational and administrative functions for the Orlando region.

“I am looking forward to working in partnership with Chief Anthony Holloway and the entire department as we continue to champion existing and future innovative neighborhood policing initiatives. I embrace the opportunity and look forward to the challenges of serving and protecting the citizens and visitors of Clearwater,” said Wilson.

Wilson's appointment is effective December 4.
