WHAT: Domestic Battery/Serious Injury Crash

WHEN: Domestic Battery: reported at 8:43 a.m.

WHERE: Domestic Battery: 2070 Brampton Road, Clearwater, FL.
Vehicle Crash: Sunset Point Road at Macomber Avenue, Clearwater, FL

WHY: The Clearwater Police Department Traffic Homicide Investigation Team is investigating a serious injury crash that occurred at 8:49 a.m. on Sunset Point Road. Investigators say Charles Moore was headed westbound on Sunset Point Road at a high rate of speed when he struck another vehicle from behind. The driver of that vehicle, Barbara Sandike, was transported to Mease Dunedin with non-life threatening injuries. Moore was transported to Bayfront with life-threatening injuries.

Traffic Homicide Investigators say they are still determining whether this crash was intentional. They are investigating the possibility that Moore lost control due to the high rate of speed at which he was traveling.

This crash happened shortly after a domestic battery committed by the suspect at his residence. According to detectives, the suspect made statements about taking his life and left his residence in a vehicle.

Traffic homicide investigators and detectives will make the final determination as to the intent and cause of the crash. The investigation continues...
