- WHY:** The Clearwater Police Department, the Clearwater Parks and Recreation Department and the Rotary Club of Clearwater partnered to award over a dozen students a one-year recreational scholarship for them and their families through the "Good ACT" Program. Students are kindergarteners through eighth-graders and were nominated by teachers, mentors and police officers.

The students were selected for performing random acts of kindness, exceptional grades in school, being helpful to peers in school or displaying model behavior.

The membership is valid at all City of Clearwater Recreation Centers, including the North Greenwood Aquatic Center and the Ross Norton Extreme Sports Park. The pass is good for the student and his or her family members.

The Good ACT program, created in 2003, began at the North Greenwood Recreation and Aquatic Center and has made hundreds of awards to deserving youth in our community. The name Good ACT is an acronym for "Aquatic Center Time."
