**WHY:** Some children will kick off their first day of summer vacation with a free pass to the City of Clearwater recreation centers. Several students will be recognized for random acts of kindness, exceptional grades in school, being helpful to peers in school or making a positive turnaround in school behavior.

The Clearwater Police Department in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Clearwater and the Clearwater Parks and Recreation Department will award twenty students a one-year recreational scholarship through the "Good ACT" Program. The name is an acronym for "Aquatic Center Time." Students are kindergarteners through eighth-graders and were nominated by teachers or mentors.

The membership is valid at all City of Clearwater Recreation Centers, including the North Greenwood Aquatic Center and the Ross Norton Extreme Sports Park.

The Good ACT program, created in 2003, began at the North Greenwood Recreation and Aquatic Center and has made hundreds of awards to deserving youth in our community.
