OPERATION MEDICINE CABINET: DISPOSE OF EXPIRED OR UNUSED PRESCRIPTIONS

Clearwater, Fla. - The Clearwater Police Department in conjunction with other law enforcement agencies and is conducting "Operation Medicine Cabinet." The event is an opportunity for citizens to safely discard unused or expired prescription medications, with no questions asked. The multi-agency effort is aimed at addressing the problem of prescription drug abuse and keeping a clean environment.

Citizens can stop by on Saturday, May 15th from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. and drop off their medications for safe collection and disposal. Please be aware that no bio-hazards or needles will be accepted and that the program is intended for private citizens of Pinellas County and not for commercial use. There are 10 drop-off locations in Pinellas County:
