## DOUBLE HOMICIDE SUSPECTS CHARGED WITH A THIRD HOMICIDE

**WHO:** Isidro Santiago Jones (Arrested)  
DOB: 7-2-91  
Clearwater, Fla.  
Charge: Murder in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree

Carlos Benito Jones (Arrested)

**WHAT:** Homicide/Murder in the 1<sup>st</sup> Degree

**WHERE:** Palmetto Street and Fairburn Avenue  
Clearwater, Fla.

**WHEN:** September 25, 2011

**SUMMARY:** Clearwater Homicide Detectives have charged two suspects in a September 2011 homicide. Through the course of their investigation, Detectives identified Isidro Santiago and Carlos Jones (brothers) as the suspects in the shooting death of Zorana Lebedic. Lebedic was shot and killed during the course of a robbery as she rode her bicycle at the above listed location the night of September 25, 2011.

Ballistics confirmed the same gun was used in a double homicide at Cherry Harris Park on October 15. The Jones brothers were arrested and charged in connection with the double homicide and

are currently being held at the Pinellas County Jail. Today, Detectives added the charge of 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Murder for both Isidro and Carlos Jones. They are also facing charges from PCSO for a robbery that occurred in Dunedin on September 25 about 45 minutes prior to the homicide.
