SUMMARY:

Vehicle #1 was traveling eastbound on Gulf to Bay Boulevard (SR60) and proceeded into the left turn lane at Lake Ave. Vehicle #2 was traveling westbound on SR60 in the median lane approaching the intersection of Lake Ave. The driver of Vehicle #1 turned into the path of Vehicle 2 which resulted in a serious crash.

The impact caused one unrestrained child (2-year-old) to be ejected from the vehicle. He and the 8-year-old male were transported by air to Bayfront Medical Center with serious injuries. The two other passengers sustained non-life threatening injuries and were transported to local hospitals.

The driver of Vehicle #1 was not injured. The driver of Vehicle #2 was transported to Morton Plant Hospital for minor injuries. At the time, one child (8-year-old) remains in critical condition and all others have been downgraded non-life threatening injuries.

Westbound lanes of Gulf to Bay reopened at 3:30 hrs.
