**Involved Employee**

Officer Woodie has been with the agency for 9 years 9 months.

**Allegation**

On October 30, 2025, Officer Langston Woodie entered a private residence after consent was withdrawn and arrested one of the residents without probable cause. The appropriate general orders for the allegations are as follows:

**Improper Searches and Seizures** (212.60) - No member shall make an improper search or seizure or an arrest or detention not in accordance with current agency directives. Members shall respect the constitutional and civil rights of all arrested or detained persons. (2 counts)

**Falsifying Reports** (213.64) - Members shall not knowingly falsify personal or city records or reports, including accident, insurance, or medical records or reports; employment applications; purchase orders; time sheets or any other reports, record, applications, or correspondence.

**Paperwork Submission** (212.63) - Members shall ensure that any official paperwork is complete, accurate, and consistent with the investigation. Paperwork is to be filed by the scheduled due date. This paperwork includes but is not limited to evaluations, reports, time sheets, etc.

**Disposition**

Based on the facts documented in the administrative investigation, the Discipline Review Board sustained the allegations against Officer Woodie.

**Discipline/Corrective Action**

In accordance with progressive discipline guidelines, Officer Woodie was Terminated.
