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**Involved Employee**

Officer Woodie has been with the agency for 9 years.

**Allegation**

On July 23, 2025 Officer Langston Woodie took his Assigned Patrol vehicle home before the commencement of his suspension. The appropriate general order for the allegation is as follows:

212.41 Persons in Vehicles – Members shall use city vehicles only as authorized and shall not use city vehicles for personal accommodation or to transport others in violation of the Take Home Vehicle Policy.

212.63 Paperwork Submission – Members shall ensure that any official paperwork is complete, accurate, and consistent with the investigation. Paperwork is to be filed by the scheduled due date. This paperwork includes but is not limited to evaluations, reports, time sheets, etc.

**Disposition**

Based on the facts documented in the administrative investigation, the Discipline Review Board sustained the allegations against Officer Woodie.

**Discipline/Corrective Action**

In accordance with progressive discipline guidelines, Officer Woodie received a 2-day suspension and permanent revocation from the take home vehicle privilege.
