PII refers to Personal Identifying Information (home address, phone, date of birth, SSN, spouse, and children).

- > the Florida Commission on Offender Review
- > law enforcement agents
- > school superintendents and their designees
- > any licensed professional or licensed community agency representative participating in the assessment or treatment of a juvenile
- > and others entitled under this chapter to receive that information
- > or upon order of the court.

119.071(3)(a)(3) SECURITY AND FIRE SAFETY PLANS; such confidential and exempt information may be disclosed:

- > To the property owner or leaseholder; or
- > In furtherance of the official duties and responsibilities of the agency holding the information; or
- > To another local, state, or federal agency in furtherance of that agency's official duties and responsibilities; or
- > Upon a showing of good cause before a court of competent jurisdiction.

119.071(3), F.S., BODY CAMERA RECORDING states that a body camera recording may be disclosed by a law enforcement agency

- > in furtherance of its official duties and responsibilities; or
- > to another governmental agency in furtherance of its official duties and responsibilities

119.071(4), F.S., states that a body camera recording may be disclosed by a law enforcement agency

- > to a person recorded by a body camera (only portions relevant to person's presence)
- > to the personal representative of a person recorded by a body camera (only portions relevant to person's presence)
- > to a person not depicted in a body camera recording if the recording depicts a place in which a person lawfully resided, dwelled, or lodged at the time of the recording (only portions that record the interior of such a place)
- > Pursuant to a court order

"Personal Representative" means a parent, a court-appointed guardian, an attorney, or an agent of, or a person holding a power of attorney for, a person recorded by a body camera. If a person depicted in the recording is deceased, the term also means the personal representative of the estate of the deceased person; the deceased person's surviving spouse, parent, or adult child; the deceased person's attorney or agent; or the parent or guardian of a surviving minor child of the deceased. An agent must possess written authorization of the recorded person to act on his or her behalf.

Section 119.011(3)(c), F.S., states that the following information is NOT criminal investigative or criminal intelligence information:

- > The time, date, location and nature of a reported crime;
- > The name, sex, age, and address of a person arrested (but see pages 108-111 regarding confidentiality of certain juvenile crime records) or the name, sex, age and address of the victim of a crime, except as provided in s. 119.071(2)(h) or (o). F.S. Section 119.071(2) (h), F.S., provides confidentiality for information revealing the identity of a victim of a sexual offense, child abuse, or a child victim of human trafficking
- > Section 119.071(2)(o), F.S., provides that the address of a victim of an incident of mass violence is exempt.
- > The time, date and location of the incident and of the arrest;
- > The crime charged;

Narrative

SYNOPSIS OF EVENT:

On 07/24/2025 at approximately 1021 hours, at 1040 Eldorado Ave, I responded to a possible medical emergency. Sunstar (run # 25-5466304) and FD46 (run # 5120103) responded and performed CPR. Terry Bollea was transported to Morton Plant Hospital and was pronounced deceased at 1117 hours.

INVESTIGATIVE ACTION TAKEN:

On 07/24/2025 at approximately 1021 hours I, Officer J. Bailey, responded to 1040 Eldorado Ave in reference to a medical call. Upon arrival, Sunstar EMS and Clearwater Fire Department were on scene. I entered through the front door of the residence, on the second floor, which leads to the living room. I observed personnel from Sunstar and FD actively performing CPR on Terry Bollea, who was lying supine on the floor in the living room, between a recliner and the TV. Mr. Bollea was pale and I did not observe any signs of life. The home appeared very neat, clean, and orderly.

Adjacent to this room was the kitchen/dining area, where Home Health Aide - Dana Swinton and Occupational Therapist - Justin McCamey were standing by. I briefly spoke to them and they advised they were present when Mr. Bollea became unresponsive.

The following is a summary dialogue I had with Dana Swinton and Justin McCamey shortly after arrival, prepared after reviewing my body-worn camera after the incident occurred. Please refer to the original body worn camera footage for the complete conversation:

Officer Bailey: "Who all was here?"

Dana Swinton: "We were. Me, the occupational therapist, and the wife."

Officer Bailey: "You said the wife as well?"

Dana Swinton: "Ye... Is she outside? Oh, ok, here she comes. Us three were here."

Justin McCamey: "I'm the OT that came in to do home health."

Officer Bailey: "Was this, like, a witnessed thing?"

Justin McCamey: "Oh yea, we saw it."

Officer Bailey: "What all happened?"

Justin McCamey: "So... we're trying not to say much in front of her but he is in rough shape. We knew this was gonna be happening."

Came in, did the... chest wasn't elevating. Couldn't wake him up."

Officer Bailey: "No, but before, like, did someone witness him go into cardiac arrest?"

Justin McCamey: "No he just... stopped breathing."

Dana Swinton: "No, I got here at 7, he was... ok, I got here at 7. No he was, literally, we went to the bathroom and from there to there in a matter of 30 seconds he was breathing. And then we came back..."

Officer Bailey: "Ok, but so he (Mr. Bollea) went to the bathroom and came back?"

Justin McCamey: "No, he (Mr. Bollea) was in the recliner the whole time."

Officer Bailey: "But ya'll were here before?"

Dana Swinton: "I've been here since 7."

Justin McCamey: "I got here like 10 minutes before this happened."

Dana Swinton: "I mean he wasn't as up as he was Saturday and Sunday when I had him, but he was still talking this morning, a little low, a little mumbly. I got him in the chair, he ate a little yogurt, he was fine. Set him up there, like... set him up in a chair. He came in this, where he was asleep, but he was breathing. He (Justin McCamey) went to go to the bathroom, by the time he came out of the bathroom (Justin McCamey), he tries to do a pulse on him (Mr. Bollea)."

Justin McCamey: "Not with the patient... she and I were taking care of something in the bathroom, making sure it was set up."

Dana Swinton: "The patient was in the chair. By the time he came to do the vitals for the visit he's on, there was no pulse. He (Mr. Bollea) hasn't been moved, I'd say, he probably got down... probably... I'd say he got down here probably at 8:30 - 8:45, which we got down here, he's been down here."

Dana Swinton then prepared to drive Melanie Bollea to the hospital. Melanie Bollea (Mr. Bollea's Wife/Next of Kin) came downstairs and advised she would ride to the hospital with Dana Swinton. Sunstar transported Mr. Bollea to Morton Plant Hospital and we exited the house at which time Melanie locked the front door.

I remained on scene and spoke with Justin McCamey who provided the following information: Justin is an Occupational Therapist for Tampa General Hospital - Visiting Nursing Association (VNA). Mr. Bollea has been a patient of his for approximately two (2) weeks and this is his second visit with Mr. Bollea. [REDACTED]

Justin advised he arrived at this residence at approximately 0930 hours for his visit. Mr. Bollea was propped up in the recliner in the living room. At approximately 0940 hours, Justin attempted to get a standard set of vitals on Mr. Bollea and noted he could not find a pulse. They began to perform CPR until Sunstar/FD arrived. Justin advised Mr. Bollea's health has been very poor ever since the surgery. Mr. Bollea has had approximately 20-30 various knee, hip, and back surgeries over the years. Justin displayed the following list of medications from a tablet that he had from Mr. Bollea's medical history:

Justin had concluded talking about the medical episode that occurred today. I muted my BWC as he began discussing Mr. Bollea's medical history and engaged in small talk. Justin then left the scene but advised he could be reached by his cell phone for any further questions. This concluded my interview with Justin.

Officer Banks was at Morton Plant Hospital and reported to me that Mr. Bollea's time of death was announced at 1117 hours.

At approximately 1630 hours, myself and Officer J. Albis spoke with Melanie at her residence. We requested to take custody of Mr. Bollea's medications, which she provided to us. Officer J. Albis took custody of these pills to submit into property/evidence, please see his supplemental report for details.

Clearwater Police Officers remained on scene for security until the conclusion of the call. I remained on scene until approximately 1700 hours in the event there were any media/crowd issues.

Nothing further to report at this time.

On 7/24/25, Sergeant Beaver notified me of an incident occurring at 1040 ELDORADO AVE in which an adult male, later identified as Terry Bollea had experienced an apparent medical emergency and emergency medical services personnel were tending to him. Sergeant Beaver requested I accompany him to Morton Plant Hospital. Sergeant Beaver and I arrived at Morton Plant Hospital where medical staff were performing life-saving measures on Mr. Bollea. A short time later, Mr. Bollea's wife, Melanie (Sky) Bollea, his son, Nicholas Bollea and friend, Christopher Volo arrived at the hospital. Sergeant Beaver and I met briefly with the above three individuals in a family consultation room within the emergency room. Mrs. Bollea stated shortly before contacting 911, her husband's occupational therapist, Justin McCamey and home health aide, Dana Swinton was at their home to assist Mr. Bollea with therapy. She continued to say Mr. Bollea was seated in his La-Z-Boy chair while Mr. McCamey was attempting to get his oxygen level by using a probe attached to his finger. Mrs. Bollea recalled that Mr. McCamey

was having a difficult time getting a reading on his oxygen level and she told Mr. McCamey due to the size of his fingers, it is sometimes difficult to obtain an accurate reading. Mr. McCamey and Ms. Swinton then went into the bathroom nearby to prepare the bathroom for the occupational therapy-related tasks he was going to have Mr. Bollea perform. When Mr. McCamey and Ms. Swinton returned a short time later, Mrs. Bollea noticed her husband did not appear to be breathing anymore. Ms. Swinton and Mr. McCamey then moved Mr. Bollea to the ground while she called 911. Mr. McCamey then began performing CPR on Mr. Bollea until first responders arrived on scene.

Sergeant Beaver and I then asked about Mr. Bollea's past medical history. Mrs. Bollea advised he had undergone a spinal surgery on his neck approximately six weeks prior to this incident and referred to the operation as a "fusion." Mrs. Bollea stated in addition to the spinal surgery, Mr. Bollea had an operation on his heart approximately three weeks ago to repair a valve. At the time of his cardiac surgery, she advised Mr. Bollea was diagnosed with chronic lymphocytic leukemia (CLL) as well. She continued to say her husband had been in the hospital for approximately three weeks following the surgery. Mrs. Bollea stated following the diagnosis of leukemia, her husband had begun chemotherapy treatment approximately one week prior.

I asked Mrs. Bollea about any medications her husband was taking and she stated he was on several different ones and was unable to provide the exact names. She explained the officers who had responded to her house had asked about the medications and were later provided the same. Please refer to additional supplements for details surrounding the specific medications Mr. Bollea was prescribed and later collected.

I asked Mrs. Bollea how her husband was behaving earlier in the morning prior to the medical incident. She stated it was a normal morning and that he had eaten a breakfast of yogurt and berries approximately fifteen minutes prior to the arrival of the occupational therapist.

I later spoke individually with Christopher Volo who works with Mr. Bollea as a manager. Mr. Volo stated Mr. Bollea had been placed on dialysis approximately 1-2 weeks prior to this incident and, from his recollection, appeared to be doing better while undergoing dialysis. Mr. Volo then stated he had been diagnosed with kidney failure as well. Mr. Volo continued to say that on this date, (7/24/25), Mr. Bollea had another dialysis appointment scheduled for later in the day.

After speaking with Mrs. Bollea and Mr. Volo, I returned to ER room 1 where Mr. Bollea was being treated. A short time later, Dr. Erica Francis pronounced Mr. Bollea deceased at 11:17 hours.

Sergeant Beaver and I then entered the room and conducted a visual inspection of Mr. Bollea's body. The body was laying supine in the hospital bed of room 1. There was an intraosseous (IO) catheter in his right shinbone. There was an intravenous catheter in his right arm. Previously, while medical personnel were providing lifesaving measures to Mr. Bollea, I noticed they were utilizing an automated, mechanical chest compression device. There were no signs of trauma to the body except for redness and an apparent abrasion from where the compression device had been placed on his sternum. I also noted Mr. Bollea appeared to have swelling in his ankles and lower portions of his legs.

Sergeant Beaver took eight (8) photographs of Mr. Bollea with his department-issued cellular phone. Sergeant Beaver and I then uploaded the photographs to Axon Evidence.com and their access was restricted. After the photographs were uploaded to evidence.com, I witnessed Sergeant Beaver delete the photographs from his department issued cell phone.

I later made phone contact with the lead nurse who had been treating Mr. Bollea, Eleanor Rowe to confirm the name of the physician who was signing the death certificate. Ms. Rowe stated Mr. Bollea's primary care physician, Dr. Gerald Fitzgerald had been made aware by hospital staff of Mr. Bollea's passing and would be signing the death certificate.

Ms. Rowe explained Mr. Bollea's family had opted to utilize Sylvan Abbey for their funeral arrangements. She advised the hospital would coordinate with Sylvan Abbey to take custody of Mr. Bollea's remains. It should be noted; I was not at the hospital when Sylvan Abbey staff arrived.

This case remains open.

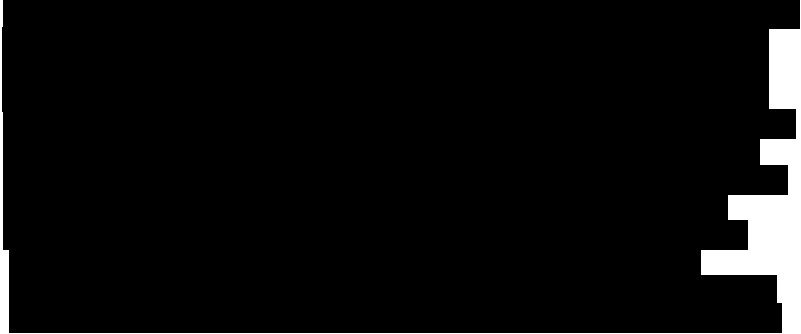

Next Sgt. Curtis and I began to count the contents of each prescription bottle contained within the evidence bag. As we counted the contents of the bottles, I logged each count and prescribed information onto CPD form 95 (Prescription Log Form).

At the conclusion of the count and recording of same, Sgt. Curtis transported the same property which was initially removed from locker #14 back to the main station and repackaged same into a new evidence heat sealed bag and label.

On July 24, 2025 at approximately 1025 hours, I observed a call for service at 1040 Eldorado Ave where an adult male patient was in cardiac arrest and medical personnel were on scene performing CPR. At approximately 1032 hours, it was reported that the male patient, identified as Terry Bollea was being transported by Ambulance to Morton Plant Hospital.

Being the CID Supervisor on duty, I contacted Detective Daniel Bieber. At that time we responded to Morton Plant Hospital (which is located at 300 Pinellas Street) to speak with family members of Mr. Bollea.

Upon our arrival at Morton Plant Hospital, medical staff were actively attempting life saving measures on Mr. Bollea. Detective Bieber and I met with Mr. Bollea's wife, Melanie Bollea and son, Nicholas Bollea in ER Room #8 (Family Waiting Room). Please see Detective Bieber's supplemental report #1 for details of his interviews with Melanie and Nicholas.

Upon returning to ER Room #1 after speaking with Melanie and Nicholas, medical staff informed Detective Bieber and I that Mr. Bollea was pronounced deceased at 1117 hours by Dr. Erica Frances.

A short time later, Detective Bieber and I conducted a visual inspection of Mr. Bollea's body as he remained in ER Room #1 where I observed the following:

Mr. Bollea was laying supine in the hospital bed. I observed an intraosseous (IO) catheter in his right shinbone. There was an intravenous catheter in his right arm. Previously, while medical personnel were providing lifesaving measures to Mr. Bollea, I noticed they were utilizing an automated, mechanical chest compression device. I did not observe any signs of trauma to Mr. Bollea except for redness and an apparent abrasion from where the compression device had been placed on his sternum. I also noted Mr. Bollea appeared to have swelling in his ankles and lower portions of his legs and was wearing compression socks.

Upon inspecting Mr. Bollea, I did not observe any evidence suggesting any suspicious circumstances.

I then utilized my police issued cell phone and captured eight (8) photographs of Mr. Bollea. Upon later returning to the main station, I uploaded the photographs into Axon Evidence.com and restricted the photographic evidence. After the photographs were uploaded, I deleted the photographs from my department issued cell phone in front of Detective Bieber.

Just prior to going off duty, I reviewed Officer Jordan Bailey's original report and observed that he had documented the medication names that Mr. Bollea was prescribed, however, the report did not mention the collection of these medications. Based on Major Burnside being on scene at Mr. Bollea's residence, I contacted him and inquired on this. It was explained that due to Melanie urgently rushing out of the residence to see Mr. Bollea at Morton Plant Hospital, Officers were unable to request the medication from inside the residence at that time.

I then contacted Officer Bailey, and requested he go back to Mr. Bollea's residence to collect the medications. Officer Bailey informed me that he would be going off duty shortly. It was determined that he and Officer Jay Albies would collect the medications

from the residence, and Officer Albies would conduct a count of the medications and then submit them into evidence.

As my supervisor duties, I followed up with the count of the medications later in the evening. While reviewing the medication log completed by Officer Albies on Evidence.com, I observed several clerical errors.

Due to this, I contacted on duty District I Patrol Sergeant Gary Martinez and arrangements were made for him to conduct a second count of the medication and to complete a second medication log. (Please see Sgt. Martinez' supplemental report #3 for details and his involvement).

After Sergeant Martinez' count, I was advised that some of the medications listed on the form that was provided to Officer Bailey were not in the bag of medications provided by Melanie. I then reviewed the medication log and observed that the medication, [REDACTED] showed a discrepancy in how many pills should be left in the pill vial.

Based on these circumstances, on July 25, 2025 at approximately 0900 hours, I contacted the Pinellas County Medical Examiner's Office and spoke with MEO Investigator Jim Beining to advise on the above discrepancy in the medication. While speaking with Beining, I was informed that the Medical Examiner's Office was aware of the recent surgery on Mr. Bolleas's neck where it was alleged that the phrenic nerve had been damaged.

Beining contacted me a short time later and advised that after conferring with his supervisor, Damon Breton, they would not be conducting an autopsy on Mr. Bollea.

Detective Bieber and I then met with Nicholas and asked about the medications that were listed on the piece of paper provided to Officer Baily that were not in the medication bag. Nicholas informed Detective Bieber and I that his father had many surgeries performed over the years. He explained when discharged from the hospital, certain medications would remain on the discharge paperwork even though his father was not taking those certain medications. Nicholas advised that if any other medications were located at his father's residence, he or Melanie would contact me and have the medications given to us.

This concludes my involvement in this case.

INVESTIGATIVE SUPPLEMENT:

On Thursday, August 7, 2025, at approximately 1431 hrs., Terry Bollea's daughter Brooke Bollea contacted me in reference to information on her father, specifically, whether an autopsy would be performed. I explained that the decision on whether an autopsy should be performed is the responsibility of the Medical Examiner.

Ms. Bollea went on to say that she was concerned with her father's recent medical history, advising that she was told recently that medical personnel may have "botched" his recent surgery. I explained that we heard the same unconfirmed allegation, but that we would look into it.

Ms. Bollea also brought up her concerns of cremation in relation to an outside private autopsy. I explained that those decisions were up to the legal next of kin and suggested she discuss this with "Sky".

Ms. Bollea thanked me for taking her call and assisting her as much as I could. Prior to ending the call, Ms. Bollea inquired about any/all lab work available related to her father's death. I advised I would send over the phone numbers to Morton Plant Hospital Legal Division in reference to this.

I offered my condolences to the loss of her father and ended the call.

At approximately 1550 hours, I provided Ms. Bollea, with the following Morton Plant Hospital Corporate Legal Department phones number (727) 519-1883 to include their Legal Aid Department (727-443-0656.)

On Tuesday, August 21, 2025, at approximately 1416 hours, contact was made with Ms. Bollea to inquire if she would be able to meet in person at the Clearwater Police Department for the purpose of discussing the status of the investigation and to clarify some of the speculation circulating in the public.

Ms. Bollea advised that she would be unavailable until November due to previously scheduled obligations. I explained that we believed it would be appropriate share case facts with her. She acknowledged this but reiterated that she was unable to meet.

On 8/27/25 at approximately 1411 hours, I responded to the Clearwater Fire Department Administrative Offices which also houses Fire Station 45 to meet with Lt. Jennifer Pauley as she had responded to 1040 Eldorado Avenue for this case. Lt. Pauley stated she is the rescue lieutenant and her duty is to serve as the emergency medical services supervisor for the entire city while on shift. As part of her duties, she is to respond to higher priority calls such as cardiac arrest and once on scene, to assume a supervisory role and to ensure the call is handled appropriately and per protocol. Lt. Pauley stated her role is less hands-on patient care and is more related to the overall scene. I asked Lt. Pauley if she could tell me what she remembered about this call and she recalled she was delayed in arriving on scene as she was on a separate call for service in the countryside area of the city. Lt. Pauley arrived on scene at 1040 Eldorado Avenue after responding for the report of a cardiac arrest. Upon entering the residence, Lt. Pauley stated other members of Clearwater Fire/Rescue were performing lifesaving measures on Mr. Bollea who was laying on the floor. Lt. Pauley stated the lieutenant who was running the cardiac arrest was Lt. Christopher Quinn who she stated is an advanced cardiac life support (ACLS) instructor for Pinellas County EMS. I asked Lt. Pauley if she ever observed any signs of trauma on Mr. Bollea and she stated she did not. Lt. Pauley recalled Mr. Bollea was in the cardiac rhythm known as asystole which means there was no electrical activity in the heart. Lt. Pauley stated Lt. Quinn had informed her they had found Mr. Bollea in asystole upon first attaching electrodes to his body. Lt. Quinn further advised Lt. Pauley they were going to be transporting to the hospital. Lt. Pauley stated she made notifications to her chain of command and also requested that Clearwater Police respond to the scene to address any potential crowd control or scene management that may be needed once Mr. Bollea was removed from the home. Lt. Pauley also requested the assistance of Engine 44 to assist in moving Mr. Bollea from the residence. Lt. Pauley stated Lt. Quinn asked her to get whatever medical history she could from the home health workers who were present. Lt. Pauley recalled the man she spoke with was wearing scrubs and was reading some of the medical history from a tablet. The individual, identified as Justin McCamey informed her that Mr. Bollea had recently had an unknown surgery and was providing her the information from a tablet. According to Lt. Pauley, she was informed by McCamey that Mr. Bollea had been in a physical decline following the surgery which is why he had home health prescribed. Lt. Pauley stated she did not observe anything obviously concerning about Mr. Bollea's body and that none of her personnel reported anything suspicious to her either.

I had been previously advised the family had agreed to allow me to view the in-home surveillance footage captured on 7/24/25 at the time of this incident. Upon arrival, I met with Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea who introduced me to their private investigator, Douglas Smith. Smith showed me a sealed manila envelope which had been taped, signed and dated prior to my arrival. The date on the envelope was 8/10/2025. Smith opened the envelope in my presence and removed a portable hard drive. Smith stated he had been advised by the Bollea family to download the video footage from 7/24/25 onto a hard drive in case it was needed at a later date. Smith stated he downloaded the footage on 8/10/25 from the digital video recorder (DVR). Nicholas and Melanie Bollea were present while I reviewed the footage. It should be noted, the Bollea family attorney was on the phone with Nicholas for the duration as well. The video was segmented into approximately thirty minute increments and there is no audio for the footage. It should be noted, the time stamp on the video is not accurate to the real time. Based on the time stamps on the video, as compared to the times collected from the 911 call, it appears as though the times on the video are approximately one hour and forty-two minutes behind the real time. For example, the 911 call was received by the Pinellas County 911 Center at 09:51:48 hours. Mrs. Bollea can be seen placing a phone call, believed to be 911 based on her statement at 08:09 hours on the home video. The Bolleas and Smith allowed me to view the video footage from camera "5" within the home. [REDACTED] [REDACTED] Upon entering the main entrance of the home, the living room is straight ahead with a stairwell to the left. The camera angle does not capture the front door. The camera view [REDACTED] captures the couch, recliner, large bay windows and a portion of the kitchen and dining room table. I did not review any other camera footage</p>

from within or around the residence. The times listed below are as seen on the footage and are not the accurate time. Smith was able to locate the video where Mr. Bollea is first seen. At approximately 05:40 hours, Ms. Swinton can be seen pushing Mr. Bollea from behind camera view in a wheelchair. Mr. Bollea's arms and head can be seen moving at this time. Swinton moves Mr. Bollea in the chair and places him next to the recliner. She then moves a walker in front of Mr. Bollea and eventually assists him to his feet with the assistance of the walker. With Swinton's assistance, Mr. Bollea takes a series of small steps, turns and then sits back into the recliner. It appears as though Swinton forgot to place a cushion underneath Mr. Bollea so she again assists him to his feet with the help of the walker, places the cushion underneath his buttocks and he again sits in the recliner. Swinton then lifts Mr. Bollea's legs up and places a large, wedge shaped bolster, propping his legs up and reclining the rear of the chair slightly. At approximately 05:50 hours, Swinton goes to the kitchen and retrieves what appears to be a yogurt and a container of berries from the refrigerator before taking them over to where Mr. Bollea is seated in the chair. At approximately 05:52 hours, Swinton hands Mr. Bollea the yogurt and he shakes it up for a short period of time. Swinton then passes him a spoon and he proceeds to eat the yogurt on his own.

At approximately 05:55 hours, Mrs. Bollea is seen on camera for the first time. Mrs. Bollea walks into the living room and moves the wheel chair from next to the recliner where Swinton had left it earlier. Mrs. Bollea and Swinton both appear to move around the room and Swinton can be seen assisting Mr. Bollea with utilizing a urinal.

For the next approximately two hours, Mr. Bollea can be seen watching television in the recliner. Mr. Bollea is never seen alone in the room and no individuals appear to make physical contact with him for the duration.

At approximately 07:50 hours, Mr. McCamey is seen on camera entering the residence. McCamey and Swinton can be seen speaking for several minutes during which time, McCamey appears to look at his tablet multiple times.

McCamey then walks over to the recliner in which Mr. Bollea is seated and after a few moments, places a blood pressure cuff around his arm. At this point, Mrs. Bollea is seated on the backrest of the couch next to the above-mentioned recliner. McCamey appears to begin to try to take Mr. Bollea's blood pressure. At approximately 08:08 hours, as McCamey continues to attempt to take a blood pressure, Mrs. Bollea quickly stands up and walks over to Mr. Bollea. She then places her hand on his chest and appears to notice he is not breathing.

Mrs. Bollea immediately takes out her phone and appears to place a call. This corresponds to the 911 call times received by the Pinellas County 911 center. Simultaneously, McCamey can be seen attempting to check to see if Mr. Bollea is breathing and he removes the large wedge cushion from underneath his legs.

Mrs. Bollea then places her ear to Mr. Bollea's chest and appears to attempt to perform chest compressions on him while he is still in the chair.

At 08:11 hours, McCamey and Swinton attempt to move Mr. Bollea to the ground. They can be seen moving the upper portion of his body initially and Mr. Bollea appears unresponsive. Eventually, McCamey and Swinton are able to move Mr. Bollea to the ground immediately next to the recliner and McCamey begins providing chest compressions to Mr. Bollea immediately. McCamey continues to provide chest compressions on Mr. Bollea until the arrival of Clearwater Fire/Rescue personnel who can first be seen on camera at 08:16 hours.

Swinton advised she had worked the overnight shift once or twice however, on this date had been assigned to work the day time shift. Swinton stated that she had no knowledge of Mr. Bollea's past medical history or why he had home health care ordered. She explained her role is to assist the patient with "activities for daily living" or ADL. Swinton explained ADL includes washing, use of the bathroom, feeding and similar basic needs. Swinton then went on to report that on the day Mr. Bollea died, she arrived at approximately 0650 hours for her 0700 hours start of shift. She stated Mr. Bollea was upstairs in the bathroom upstairs in his chair which was normal as compared to her last visits with him. Swinton stated when she last saw Mr. Bollea, he was moving slowly but was seemingly ok. When she arrived on 7/24, she noticed he was wearing diapers and she just recognized this as different than the last time she had seen him approximately two days</p>

prior. She went upstairs where she found Mr. Bollea in the bathroom getting ready to brush his teeth. After he did so, she assisted Mr. Bollea down the elevator in his wheelchair and to his recliner in the living room of the residence. Swinton stated Mr. Bollea did not normally eat breakfast but just ate yogurt which she gave him. She then recalled Mrs. Bollea gave him his medications that he normally takes without incident and Mr. Bollea then went to sleep. I asked Swinton if Mr. Bollea had complained of anything in particular on this day and she stated he did not however, had previously made mention of back pain however, she did not have any further details on the nature of the injury.

At approximately 0945 hours, Swinton stated the occupational therapist arrived and she showed him to the bathroom downstairs that Mr. Bollea regularly uses. She continued to say they had ordered a new toilet for him as he appeared to be getting weaker and needed a modified toilet to allow him to get up and down.

Swinton stated the occupational therapist told Mr. Bollea he would be right back to get started as he walked in but Mr. Bollea did not respond as he was asleep. After she and the occupational therapist, Justin McCamey returned from the bathroom, McCamey went to begin taking vital signs of Mr. Bollea. Swinton reported McCamey was having a difficult time obtaining a pulse from Mr. Bollea's fingers and Swinton told him his fingers may be cold and he should warm them up as that has helped her in the past. McCamey reportedly told her he still couldn't feel his pulse and then Swinton and Mrs. Bollea went over to Mr. Bollea and Mrs. Bollea exclaimed that Mr. Bollea was not breathing anymore.

Swinton stated Mrs. Bollea called 911 and then the three of them moved Mr. Bollea to the floor at the direction of the 911 call taker. She stated the call taker then told them what to do to perform CPR and explained McCamey then performed chest compressions on Mr. Bollea until the arrival of EMS personnel. Swinton later offered to drive Mrs. Bollea to the hospital which she then did.

I asked Swinton if the medications given to Mr. Bollea on that morning were the regular medications he took and she stated to her knowledge, he had certain medications he took in the morning as well as specific medications he took in the afternoon and at night. Swinton again stated she had previously covered the night shift and recalled Mr. Bollea had a difficult time sleeping at night due to pain and discomfort and as a result, frequently slept the majority of the day.

Swinton stated she did not have any details surrounding Mr. Bollea's past medical history. I asked Swinton if she had access to Mr. Bollea's medical chart as part of her job and she stated she did not and that her company only provided her with the bare minimum information. She advised she was only told she had a high profile client in Clearwater and did not even have Mr. Bollea's name until she arrived at his residence for the first time. Swinton stated she was never informed as to why Mr. Bollea was sick and all she was told was he had just been released from the hospital and needed home health.

I then asked Swinton if she ever wrote any sort of narrative or report related to this incident to which she stated she did not. Swinton explained she called her supervisors following the incident and advising them of the situation and that she had given Mrs. Bollea a ride to the hospital.

I asked Swinton if she normally writes any sort of report or does any form of documentation during the course of her job. Swinton stated she only uses an app on her phone with what she described as a check list with drop down categories for different tasks she would perform which are marked once completed. She stated the remainder of the information is passed to the oncoming caregiver via a verbal pass-down of information.

I asked Swinton how she typically gets into the home and she stated she was provided a door code to access the residence on her own. She stated once she arrived, she would usually receive an update from Mrs. Bollea as far as how the night went with him. On the date of the incident, she stated there was nothing abnormal that was reported to her other than Mr. Bollea reportedly had a scheduled doctor's appointment at 1130 but Swinton did not know what it was for.

I then confirmed with Swinton that she had never written any sort of narrative or document for this incident or any of the other times she cared for Mr. Bollea and concluded the interview.

<p>Previous Case Status: Open</p> <p>Investigative Actions Taken:</p> <p>On 11/19/25, at approximately 0900 hours, Detective Murray and I, at the request of Justin McCamey, met him at the Visiting Nurses Association Office in New Port Richey, Florida to conduct an interview with him.</p> <p>The following is a summation of the interview and is not intended to be a verbatim account. Please refer to the body worn camera footage for further details.</p> <p>I began by asking McCamey about his training and experience in relation to his job. He explained he is an occupational therapist and in order to practice as one, a bachelor's of science degree in occupational therapy was required. I asked McCamey to describe his role and he explained he is responsible for assisting the patient with function, strength, balance and endurance following an injury or illness. McCamey stated they also make equipment recommendations for the home that would assist the patient in an effort to keep the patient out of the hospital.</p> <p>I then asked McCamey to detail what his involvement was in the treatment of Mr. Bollea. McCamey explained he arrived on the morning of 7/24/25 at approximately 0900 hours. He had previously suggested that Mr. Bollea utilize a device that would assist him with utilizing the toilet as he was experiencing difficulty getting up and down before and after use. The device would elevate the surface and provide arm rests that the patient can use as support. Upon his arrival, McCamey went into the bathroom where the device had been installed to ensure it had been placed properly. McCamey explained this was his second visit and that during the first visit, he completed an initial assessment of what Mr. Bollea's needs would be and how he could provide assistance.</p> <p>McCamey advised that when he arrived, he saw Mr. Bollea asleep while seated in his recliner in the living room of the residence. in the home were Mrs. Bollea and the home health aid, Dana Swinton.

McCamey then came back into the living room and got a brief overview from Swinton as to how things were going. McCamey stated Mr. Bollea was on his supplemental oxygen and was asleep in the chair. He then spoke with Mrs. Bollea to get an update from her as to Mr. Bollea's overall status. After doing so, he went to the chair where Mr. Bollea was laying to begin taking vital signs which is what he would normally do before beginning any treatment. McCamey advised he noticed something was, "off" with Mr. Bollea. I asked what made him feel that way and he stated he noticed a different sound of the supplemental oxygen that Mr. Bollea was on and noted it was silent and he could not hear him breathing.

McCamey stated once he began attempting to take vital signs to include pulse and blood pressure, he realized Mr. Bollea was not breathing. McCamey stated he tried to listen to a heart beat utilizing his stethoscope and was unable to hear a heartbeat as well. Around the same time, he stated Mrs. Bollea exclaimed, "he's not breathing," prompting him to tell her to call 911 which she did. Simultaneously, he called his supervisor on speakerphone to advise her of the situation. McCamey stated for the duration of the time he was there with Mr. Bollea, he did not speak and was not awake at any point.

McCamey stated it took him, Mrs. Bollea and Swinton to move Mr. Bollea to the ground whereupon he began performing chest compressions until the arrival of EMS and fire department personnel who then took over for him.

I asked McCamey if he observed any obvious signs of trauma or injury to Mr. Bollea and he stated he did not have access to most of his body as it was covered in clothing but what was exposed to him did not have any apparent signs of injury.

I then asked McCamey what he knew about Mr. Bollea's past medical history. He explained he received all of the information from the medical records that are provided to him via his tablet. McCamey explained his company, Visiting Nurses Association is partnered with Tampa General Hospital and as a result, he is provided access to the medical records pertinent for the care of his patients. McCamey explained he received the medical records from Tampa General Hospital as well as the notes previously authored by other care providers who had seen Mr. Bollea.

I then showed McCamey a clip of body worn camera footage from Ofc. Bailey's camera when McCamey spoke about the phrenic nerve injury. In the clip, McCamey can be heard telling Ofc. Bailey that the nerve had been "severed" during surgery and that it was hard to do. I asked McCamey how he came to know about the phrenic nerve injury and he stated it was in the medical record. I asked how he knew the specific injury that occurred to the nerve and he initially stated it was in the medical record. I then asked again if it specifically said the nerve was severed and he stated, "well, I don't remember exactly but it's an injury that can happen." McCamey stated medical complications are common during surgeries and he frequently sees patients who have experienced them. In response, I asked if he had ever seen a patient suffering from this injury and he stated he had not.

In the body worn camera footage, McCamey says to Ofc. Bailey, "the doctor screwed up" in reference to the injury to the phrenic nerve. I then played this portion of the video and asked McCamey how he knew the doctor had, "screwed up" and in response he said, "I don't...but it was...if a phrenic nerve got severed it's assumed." I also asked McCamey how he knew that the severing of a phrenic nerve is a difficult thing to do as he stated to Ofc. Bailey. McCamey stated he did not know that it was but had assumed as much. I asked McCamey how he was able to determine the nerve was severed and he again referenced the medical record but did not have any formal basis from which he drew to establish the conclusion that it was difficult to do so.

I then concluded the interview with McCamey.

Lightfoot and I went to 12464 Indian Rocks Road, the office of Dr. Gerald Fitzgerald to conduct an interview with him.</p> <p>Cpl. Lightfoot and I met with Dr. Fitzgerald and advised we were there to speak with him in reference to a former patient of his, Terry Bollea. Dr. Fitzgerald then escorted us to a room in order to have a private conversation. The interview was recorded on a pocket digital recorder and the recording was later uploaded to evidence.com. The following is a summation of the interview and is not intended to serve as a verbatim account. Please refer to the recording for further details. I began by asking Dr. Fitzgerald how Bollea became a patient of his and he stated he believed he had Mr. Bollea as a patient for approximately ten to fifteen years after being referred to him by another patient of Dr. Fitzgerald. I then confirmed with Dr. Fitzgerald that he had signed Mr. Bollea's death certificate and after he did so, I asked how he was made aware of Mr. Bollea's passing. Dr. Fitzgerald went on to say he had previously "ran the ER" at Suncoast Hospital and knew several physicians at Morton Plant Hospital. Dr. Fitzgerald stated he received a call from Dr. Erika Francis, the attending physician in the emergency department on the day Mr. Bollea was taken in. Dr. Francis informed Dr. Fitzgerald that Mr. Bollea had come into the ER in asystole and remained in that cardiac rhythm for the duration. Dr. Fitzgerald was advised that Mr. Bollea remained in asystole for approximately forty-five minutes while lifesaving measures were employed however, he did not have any cardiac rhythm changes and</p>

was ultimately pronounced deceased.

Dr. Fitzgerald explained that due to the fact that Mr. Bollea was in asystole for such a prolonged period of time, he believed the cause of his death to be cardiac in nature and agreed to sign the death certificate and advised Morton Plant Hospital staff of the same. Dr. Fitzgerald advised that after learning of the death of Mr. Bollea, he contacted Mrs. Bollea and asked if she wished to have an autopsy performed to which she reportedly stated she did not.

Dr. Fitzgerald advised the last time he saw Mr. Bollea was in December of 2024 according to his medical chart however, believed he may have seen him at another point between then and when he had his cervical surgery. Dr. Fitzgerald later confirmed via his billing staff that he last saw Mr. Bollea as a patient on 12/20/2024. I asked Dr. Fitzgerald if he was aware of any of Mr. Bollea's surgeries that he underwent in 2025 and he stated he was not part of it and only learned of them after his death.

I asked Dr. Fitzgerald what he treated Mr. Bollea for and he stated he was just a general family practitioner and treated him for minor colds, sore throats and similar ailments.

I asked Dr. Fitzgerald if he knew anything about Mr. Bollea's medical history in the months preceding his death and he stated he only knew about a neck surgery he had. Dr. Fitzgerald advised he was told by friends of Mr. Bollea that the surgery had been successful and that Mr. Bollea was happy that he was able to feel his hands again and felt as though the surgery was a success.

Dr. Fitzgerald advised he did not believe he had seen Mr. Bollea in the time between the cervical surgery and his death.

Dr. Fitzgerald was able to provide the last contact his office had with Mrs. Bollea occurred on July 16th, 2025 advising she was unhappy with the assigned home health from Baycare and did not wish to have home health care at that time. Dr. Fitzgerald later stated he was provided the plan of care for home health and his role was simply to sign off on the plan provided by the hospital.

I provided my contact information to Dr. Fitzgerald and concluded the interview.

The following serves as a summary of the investigation into the death of Terry Gene Bollea. It is not intended to provide specific details for individual investigative steps. Please refer to the appropriate report for additional details.

On 7/24/25, at 09:50 hours, the Pinellas County Regional 911 center received a call at 1040 Eldorado Avenue for a possible cardiac arrest. Clearwater Fire Department and Sunstar personnel arrived on scene within minutes and immediately radioed that they were working a cardiac arrest.

At 10:18 hours, the Clearwater Police Department communications center received a call from the Pinellas County Regional 911 Center requesting law enforcement respond to the scene as a matter of protocol for a cardiac arrest. The Clearwater Police Department was advised at the time that EMS personnel were currently performing CPR on the patient and police officers responded for an "assist other agency" call. Upon the arrival of officers Jordan Bailey and Jay Albis, they observed members of Clearwater Fire Department performing lifesaving measures on Terry Bollea in the living room of the residence.

Officers observed Melanie "Sky" Bollea present in the residence along with two employees from Mr. Bollea's assigned home health company, Visiting Nurses Association. The two healthcare workers were identified as Justin McCamey, an occupational therapist, and Dana Swinton, a home health aide.

Shortly after the arrival of Clearwater Police officers, EMS personnel moved Mr. Bollea to the ambulance and transported him to Morton Plant Hospital in cardiac arrest. Care was transferred to the staff of Morton Plant ER whereupon Mr. Bollea was pronounced deceased at 11:17 hours following approximately forty-five minutes of lifesaving measures.

Officer Bailey spoke briefly with Ms. Swinton prior to her departure from the scene at which time she stated she had arrived at approximately 07:00 hours and assisted Mr. Bollea with breakfast and positioning within his recliner. Ms. Swinton reported she and Mr. McCamey went to the bathroom to set it up for the scheduled therapy and shortly after returning, Mr. McCamey went to check Mr. Bollea's vital signs and discovered he was pulseless.

At this time, Mrs. Bollea was with them in the immediate vicinity of Mr. Bollea as she called 911. They were able to move Mr. Bollea to the ground where Mr. McCamey immediately began performing chest compressions on him until EMS personnel arrived on scene. Ofc. Bailey conducted an interview with Mr. McCamey who identified himself as a home health occupational therapist, contracted by Tampa General Hospital. Mr. McCamey informed Ofc. Bailey, he had arrived approximately ten minutes before the incident occurred. Mr. McCamey reported after he and Ms. Swinton had gone to the bathroom to set up the room for the scheduled therapy for the day. Mr. McCamey then attempted to take vital signs on Mr. Bollea. Mr. McCamey stated he did not feel a pulse, and he called his supervisor before they were able to move him to the ground and begin CPR.

Mr. McCamey displayed a tablet device to Ofc. Bailey which contained Mr. Bollea's medical records to include a list of medications. Mr. McCamey informed Ofc. Bailey that this was his second visit with Mr. Bollea and that he had been deteriorating medically. Mr. McCamey reported to Ofc. Bailey that Mr. Bollea had undergone surgery on his neck and alleged that the phrenic nerve was severed during the operation. Additionally, he reported Mr. Bollea had undergone surgery on his aortic valve within the past month or two and that this was his second visit to care for Mr. Bollea. Mr. McCamey explained to Ofc. Bailey that he had completed his initial evaluation the week prior and he, "was kinda surprised he made it through the week."

Detectives later conducted follow-up interviews with Mr. McCamey to obtain additional context surrounding his knowledge of the alleged phrenic nerve injury as well as background information concerning his training and experience. Mr. McCamey stated all information he knew regarding Mr. Bollea's medical condition was gleaned from the tablet his company provides him. Mr. McCamey advised he had no prior or additional knowledge regarding Mr. Bollea's health conditions, other than what was in the medical record on his tablet.

Mr. McCamey also confirmed that he is not and was not a medical doctor and possesses a license in occupational therapy only. Mr. McCamey stated when he made comments about the phrenic nerve injury, he spoke out of turn and was nervous after having just performed CPR on Mr. Bollea, which was the first time he had done so in his life.

Contact was made with Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea at Morton Plant Hospital where further details surrounding Mr. Bollea's medical history were obtained. According to Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea, Mr. Bollea had been suffering from numerous medical diagnoses to include leukemia, atrial fibrillation, pneumonia and kidney failure. Additionally, Mr. Bollea had undergone multiple hospitalizations over the course of the last several months for myriad of conditions.

A statement was obtained from Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea. Mrs. Bollea reported that the occupational therapist and the home health aide had begun to set up for Mr. Bollea's therapy session for the day. She advised Mr. Bollea had been seated in his recliner in the living room of the residence and had eaten a small breakfast. As Mr. McCamey was taking vital signs, she noticed it appeared as though Mr. Bollea's chest was no longer rising and falling and she went to check on him. At this point, she and Mr. McCamey realized he did not have a pulse and Mrs. Bollea immediately called 911. 911 call recordings were obtained and corroborated the timelines and information provided by all parties involved as well as the information provided by Mrs. Bollea to the 911 call taker.

Detectives conducted a visual inspection of Mr. Bollea's body which did not reveal any signs of trauma or injury.

Morton Plant Hospital staff, following the death of Mr. Bollea, contacted his family primary care physician, Dr. Gerald Fitzgerald who advised he would sign Mr. Bollea's death certificate.

An interview was completed with Dr. Fitzgerald who reported he was Mr. Bollea's family physician for the past ten to fifteen years and saw him for general ailments. Dr. Fitzgerald stated he received a call from the attending emergency room physician at Morton Plant

Hospital on 7/24/25, Dr. Erika Francis. Dr. Fitzgerald stated he was advised by Dr. Francis that Mr. Bollea had come into the emergency department in asystole and after approximately forty-five minutes life-saving measures resulting in no cardiac rhythm changes, she pronounced Mr. Bollea deceased and asked if Dr. Fitzgerald would be willing to sign the death certificate. Dr. Fitzgerald stated that based on what he was told by Dr. Francis, he believed the cause of death was cardiac in nature and agreed to sign the certificate.

On 7/24/25, contact was made with investigators from the District VI Medical Examiner's Office who advised the case was not a medical examiner's case based on the facts and circumstances presented and as such, would not be conducting an autopsy or taking custody of Mr. Bollea's remains.

Florida Administrative Code rule 11G-2.003 and Chapter 406 of the Florida State Statutes establish the legal framework for the state's medical examiner system. Together, they govern how, when, and by whom investigations and autopsies are conducted to determine the cause and manner of death.

Officers later collected the medications currently prescribed to Mr. Bollea and conducted a pill inventory which indicated Mr. Bollea was taking fewer medications than he was prescribed.

The Clearwater Police Department enlisted the assistance of the DEA to ascertain if there were any prescribing anomalies in relation to any opiates. The DEA verified that there were no anomalous prescriptions of any opiates to Mr. Bollea by Dr. Fitzgerald or any other prescribers within the past six months. While conducting the pill inventory, detectives discovered that Mr. Bollea was taking a lower dose of the prescribed opiates, inconsistent with an individual suffering from a current addiction. Additionally, none of the medications collected by the Clearwater Police Department had been prescribed by Dr. Fitzgerald.

Due to the allegations made by Mr. McCamey indicating the possibility of an injury to Mr. Bollea being a potential proximal cause of death, several subpoena requests were completed requesting Mr. Bollea's medical records from several medical providers with consent provided by his next of kin, Mrs. Bollea. The subpoenas were ultimately served by the State Attorney's Office for the 6th Judicial Circuit to Morton Plant Hospital, Tampa General Hospital, Visiting Nurses Association and Good Samaritan Hospital. Over the course of several months, the results were received from all entities. A review of the medical records yielded several medical diagnoses and multiple, extended hospitalizations and declining health over the few months preceding Mr. Bollea's death consistent with the interviews provided by Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea.

On 8/27/25, Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea allowed Det. Bieber to review home surveillance footage from the morning of 7/24/25. The camera view captured the living room of the residence where Mr. Bollea was located at the time he went into cardiac arrest by responding officers and medical personnel. The recording was viewed in person, in the residence and it corroborated the statements previously made by Mrs. Bollea, Ms. Swinton and Mr. McCamey regarding the series of events immediately preceding and after Mr. Bollea went into cardiac arrest. The footage was not collected and remained in the family's possession.

Detectives conducted interviews with all responding emergency medical services providers. Interviewed EMS personnel also did not report seeing any signs of trauma or injury to Mr. Bollea's body.

It was later learned that Mrs. Bollea and Nicholas Bollea had arranged for a private autopsy to be completed on Mr. Bollea. The Clearwater Police Department received an abbreviated summation of the autopsy report from Dr. Daniel Schultz, the pathologist who conducted the autopsy. In his summation, Dr. Schultz writes that he performed the autopsy on 8/16/25 at 11:55 hours. Dr. Schultz writes that Mr. Bollea died, "exclusively from compelling natural disease, with no reasonable traumatic or terminal toxicologic contributions. As such, the manner of death is also natural."

Following an exhaustive review of the statements, medical records, surveillance footage from within the residence, and a visual inspection of Mr. Bollea's body, there has been no evidence to indicate the death of Terry Bollea was anything other than natural. Through the course of the investigation, there has been no evidence to indicate any criminal wrongdoing related to his death. This case will be closed, and will be considered solved, non-criminal.
